Minutes:

- Approval of minutes from last meeting by Mike McClain

Merchandise – Christine McClain

- Hoodie order that was supposed to come in back in March just came in. Will use them in the tournament sale
- There is interest from a few parents to take over merchandise sales next year.
- Express T will be doing the tournament t-shirt. Last year the T-Shirt made money
- Due to mix-up with invoices, credit due to us from Lax World – Marie will follow up

Treasurer's Report – Marie Herbst

- Summer tournaments are paid for at all levels
- Fairport & Maryland have been paid at \$1,500/tournament
- Loren advised that Saratoga needs to be paid - \$1,500
- Check for \$1,500 – Victor League
- Youth tournaments- \$5,000 will get paid
- John Pepper tournament is all paid
- No Pay Pal Balance currently
- Casino Night - \$3,200 profit
- Gerry Wilcox asked about too much money in the account - \$28,616 includes the payments coming in for tournament reimbursement
- Mike McClain wants to see how much we will profit at the tournament – not lower the cost of lowering tournament fees to players
- Loren suggested that we get through the summer before subsidizing costs back to the families.
- Still need to pay for the Varsity/Senior banquet
- Modified Marathon made \$1,592.47 after pizza, cookies, gloves & merchandizing
- Loren made a recommendation to donate additional \$200 from the marathon to Mike Pane. Gerry Wilcox made motion and Loren Herod & Marie Herbst approved motion. Donation will be sent to Ed Mulheron to give to Mike Pane

Youth – Mike Faiola

- **Summer**
 - 1st & 2nd Sackets Harbor & Homer
 - 3rd & 4th Maryland, Homer & Sackets
 - 5th & 6th Webster & Auburn
- 5th & 6th are partnering with Rush Henrietta calling the team “Man Up”

- Steve Lacrosse has refereed all the youth home games. Ed suggested giving Steve a gift card – possibly a GAS card for his plane
- Youth was given a donation check from Bob Chevez in the amount of \$100

Modified, JV & Varsity - Ed Mulheron

- Modified – Both teams are undefeated
- JV's – few in numbers
- Modified has 50 kids
- JV has 21 kids
- Varsity – Kids were a joy
- Summer – Baltimore trip cancelled – not enough players
- Next year – 25 Varsity & 25 JV – small numbers
- Summer tournaments – Fairport, West Genny and Canandaigua
- One night per week will be opportunity to play box lacrosse
- Shooting shirts did not arrive until the 1st week in May
- Ed was able to get 12 more Varsity Shirts. They were handed out as motivational shirts.
- Ed offered to give the shirts to Christine to sell
- Mike will take shirts to get them printed for next year. 73 shirts total
- Helmets – stored 20 of the 30 helmets. Will get all equipment back.
- Needs:
 - Supplementing shorts – 6 White & 6 Red each year
 - 1 player has lost his jersey – school will send a bill but will not replace the item
 - Ordered 6 helmets
- Mike McClain asked for a vote to replace shorts ahead of time and also get notified when the style changes – Loren made motion & Marie 2nd. Approved for 6 white & 6 red shorts
- 6/2/16 – Charlie Reidel's - suggestion to pay for a banner. Lisa Bellis will get the cost of a banner
